


Ensure a 150mm drainage layer made up of larger stones up to 50mm prior to backfilling with topsoil to a within Plant trees, shrubs and other plants at 'nursery layer' - or place a cane across the top of tree pit to ensure soil

All trees, shrubs bulbs and perennials to be watered once a week until established during summer, or as required in autumn.

Cut back perennials in winter or early spring to within 100mm of ground level. Split herbaceous plants as necessary if they start to out compete each other. Cut back grasses in late winter/early spring.


