PLANTING

Planting beds with topsoil: Planting by Owner Occupier To front boundary and embankments: Seeded with meadow grasses & wild flowers mixture Reference: "Meadow Mixture EM4" supplied by:-**Emorsgate Seeds** Limes Farm Tilney All Saints Norfolk P34 4RT T; 01553 829028

HEDGE PLANTING

H1 to H5 inclusive: 2No rows 1.0m apart: staggered planting at rate of 4No per linear metre.

PROTECTION

Trees & hedges to be protected against rabbits, deer, and horses. Planting beds to be mulched. Mulch to be kept back from plants.

THE LANDSCAPING WORKS

All operations shall be carried out at the optimum time of the year and in response to plant growth.


The timing of operations shall be in accordance with good horticultural practice. Each property shall be provided with permanent watering points to both the front and

EDGINGS

Edgings to parking areas, roadways, and paths to be formed using preservative treated timber fixed to preservative treated timber stakes. Top of edgings to be max of 200mm above level of parking area, roadway, and paths.


MAINTENANCE OF LANDSCAPING

The Landscaping Contractor is to be retained to carry out maintenance of the planting during the first year following completion of the lanscaping works. The maintenance to include:-* Watering as required. * Replacing damaged plant protection and tree stakes: 2No visits * Top up mulch: 2No visits * Replace any planting that has failed: 1No visits. * Remove weeds: 2No visits.


