Regarding the proposed development (SR0394) for class B use. The development of an industrial area in High Ongar would firstly create more commercial traffic. This would take away the peace and tranquillity we have at the moment. A development adjacent to dwellings would destroy the fields and farmland and take away the pleasant views which the villagers currently enjoy and would endanger the local wildlife. A development in this area would have a major negative impact on the quality of life for those who have lived in High Ongar for years and those of us who paid a premium to live in a village surrounded by country side.
