School capacity is inadequate and the curriculum requires green space.
Local GP services are already at the point of collapse.
Chemists cannot cope at the moment.
The green space is required for use by emergency air ambulances.
Our road system is inadequate: the addition of construction vehicles and resident vehicles would exacerbate the huge problems.
