We support sites Chig R1, R2, R3, R4, R7, R9 and R10  
we do NOT support R5 although part of the Nursery site accessed from the Chigwell Park Estate may be suitable.  
Chig R6 described as a Masterplan project is too vague and rejected by residents in the NDP consultation  
We are against Chig R8 and R11 as overdevelopment.

Other sites such as Land off of Luxborough Lane could have been selected in order to achieve the housing target of 376 homes by 2033.

We are saddened that better communication between EFDC and Chiswick Parish Council has not occurred and thus the ethos of the Localism Act 2011 has not been achieved.

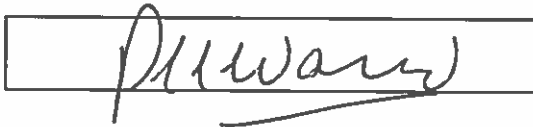
