Hi

I have only just heard about this new proposal for Limes Farm and I would like to confirm my objections to these new houses for several reasons. I recently gained information under the FOI act and Grange Hill have had more new developments than other immediate areas in Chigwell and there are still more in the pipeline, not forgetting the possibility of 110 retirement homes opposite Grange Hill Station, with cinema, cafe, gym etc all which will be open to the public. Manor Road is impossible to access now from the side roads because the sheer amount of traffic, not at any one time has the infrastructure in the Grange Hill area been improved at all, in fact one lady told me the only difference she had seen in her 38 years of living here was a bus put into service. Limes Farm is the only green space we have in this area for our childrens recreation, it is also used by dog walkers. I had an email from one of the Governments housing ministers who confirmed to me that green spaces should not be removed if they are the only one you have, which Limes is. Grange Hill cannot take anymore developments, people, cars and traffic, there is a huge problem with parking which is becoming a source of constant arguments. I would also like to point out that Councillor Phillips who I believe is in charge of the new housing proposals has reduced the number of houses to be built in Theydon Bois from 350 to 50, , Theydon should take their quota, Grange Hill is full. Please take this as my objection to be noted by the Parish Council, , our children will have nothing. I would also like to point out that I have just been out to notify people about this and no one even knew I believe this is why the response so far has been poor.
