I would like to raise my objection to the proposal to build house on the Limes Farm Green for the following reasons:

This area has always been designated as an area of parkland for the residents. For children to play and people to walk their dogs.

Apart from affecting the beauty of the estate it will add considerably to the infrastructure of the community.

It will affect congestion on the roads. One road in and one road out. The road that was opened adjacent to Manor road led to a cattle run of people trying to avoid the traffic lights and I believe was closed after a few weeks.

It will affect services at the medical centres leading to longer waiting times for appointments if more people are living on the estate. It will also affect pharmacies who are already incredibly busy.

It will affect school placements and I believe the school has a contract with the council to provide green space for the children. This is in the schools manifesto with the government to provide safe space for the children. Where will the council provide this extra space if houses are built on the field.

Safety. the air ambulance land on the green for emergencies . Where will it land if there are houses on the field.

Transport. There is one bus that serves the area. One bus will not cater for more people.

Parking. Parking is a problem already on the estate. More cars will not help the environment and safety of residents.
