To whom it may concern Re: Debden Green, Jessel Drive, Loughton, Essex I understand that Epping Forest District Council have identified the green in Jessel Drive, (opposite the Cottage Loaf public house) as a potential site for development. I am writing to express my opposition to this proposal. There are very few green open spaces left in Deben and this particular space is used by the community for many activities such as dog walking, runners to train, and funfairs for the local children. Although it is accepted that building housing is necessary I would suggest that there many other locations to build such as Chigwell Metropolitan Police sports club. It is also important to bear in mind that the proposed build will affect the local infrastructure such as putting a massive strain on local schools, local transport and other services. In addition I understand that there has been suggestion of stopping certain bus routes in the future (the 20 and/or 167) which again would be devastating to the community if this build went ahead. I will be attending council meetings when possible to take part in the debate and to express my strong concerns over this plan.
