This area has already been overdeveloped and without any additional supporting infrastructure put in place, re: Policy P 7 Chigwell Requirement, paragraphs C and D. The rush hours congestion and heavy stationary traffic pollution on Manor Road already has a
	dangerous impact on the air quality, refer to Policy P 7 on Air Pollution, paragraph E.

Policy P 7 Chigwell - Infrastructure Requirements A,B and C (iv) states that 'open space improvement' is essential; so, to build another 100 homes on the only recreational green space in Grange Hill Chigwell [CHIG.R6] would obviously be detrimental to the area.
A minimum of 100 new homes on CHIG/R6 Limes Estate would potentially mean an extra 100 vehicles joining the rush hours traffic in Grange Hill so therefore would add to the traffic congestion and produce extra pollution adding to the poor air quality.
Infrastructure requirements C. In recent years Grange Hill has already been grossly overdeveloped and without any of the promised essential infrastructure being put into place, and so to build 100's of homes on the only green space available in Grange Hill without providing the existing residents with any school expansion, health center, shops, transport links etc., is averse to the Epping Forest Council's planning requirements.
