Grounds for Representation

Any positively prepared plan would have accurately assessed the existing use of the proposed site.

Reference to the site at Debden Underground Station as "this site is a car park" indicates little or no knowledge of the location and highlights the fact that there has been no meaningful engagement or collaboration. Had the author of the Plan fulfilled their statutory obligation they would have found the site referred to accommodates a large business premises. Loughton Self Drive Ltd has occupied the site since 1994 and currently operates approximately 100 vehicles from the premises. In addition to vehicle activity, evidence of the business operating from the location, is confirmed by a significant office building, storage facilities and other buildings associated with the operation of a large scale vehicle hire business.

The economic value of the business to the local community is clearly demonstrated by an annual turnover in excess of £1 million and sizeable business rates contributions. In addition, with one exception, the 10 current employees are all residents within the Epping Forest District area.

This failure to accurately asses the site, or intentionally ignore our existence, shows a distinct lack of preparation, due diligence and total disregard to the National Planning Policy Framework guidelines for Plan-Making which clearly states...'Early and meaningful engagement and collaboration with neighbourhoods, local organisations and business is essential'. Paragraph 70 of the NPPF states that 'planning policies and decisions should: guard against the unnecessary loss of valued facilities and services...and ensure that established shops, facilities and services are able to develop and modernise in a way that is sustainable, and retained for the benefit of the community'.

We have received zero contact, collaboration, discussions regarding the proposed plans or the possibility of us co-existing within a proposed new development. This is despite the fact that the proposed plans state..'Provision should be made on site for car clubs...' Loughton Self Drive already exists on the proposed site providing safe, sustainable and affordable road transport to consumers and businesses alike, offering a full range of low emission and ultra low emission cars and Euro 5 & 6 compliant commercials. There can only have been positive benefit in incorporating our services into any new plans and avoiding the need for major traffic infrastructure, encouraging lower car use, reducing high emission vehicles and protecting and exploiting opportunities for the use of sustainable transport modes for the movement of goods or people, all consistent with the National Planning Policy Framework.

I believe I have demonstrated the proposed plan confirms a disregard for a local business which is a significant contributor to the economic and social fabric of the area. The apparent absence of compliance with the guidance contained in the NPPF challenges the integrity of the Plan in its current form. Support for such a contention

can be found in paragraph 152 of the NPPF which includes the following overarching policy advice...'Local planning authorities should seek opportunities to achieve each of the economic, social and environmental dimensions of sustainable development and net gains across all three. Significant adverse impacts on any of these dimensions should be avoided and, wherever possible, alternative options which reduce or eliminate such impacts should be pursued. Where adverse impacts are unavoidable, measures to mitigate the impact should be considered. Where adequate mitigation measures are not possible, compensatory measures may be appropriate'. Any continuance of the proposed plans in their current format would have a devastating effect and cause significant economic harm to Loughton Self Drive Ltd.

Continuance of the Site Plan with disregard for national guidance in such a perfunctory manner renders the plan indefensible and liable to successful statutory challenge. As Managing Director of Loughton Self drive Ltd I would welcome the opportunity to engage with the author of the Local Plan so that the company can continue to be a valued contributor to the social and economic development of the area. If the site is retained for development under the existing plans, then any development proposals must include provision for the relocation of Loughton Self Drive Ltd.

## 7. Suggested Changes to Submission Version of the Local Plan

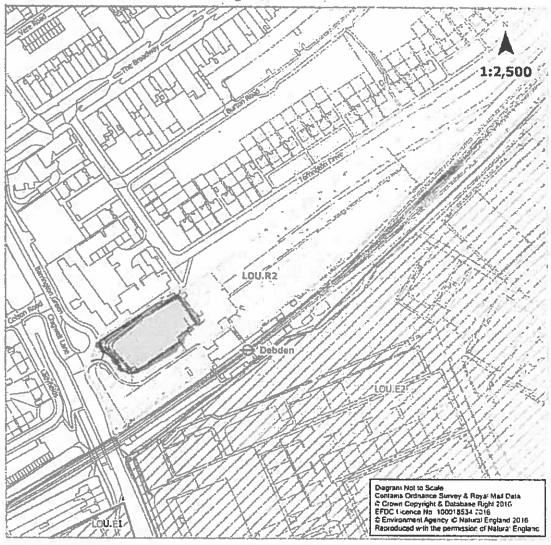

To make the plan sound and consistent with the National Planning Policy Framework we would propose Loughton Self Drive Ltd remaining in situ, co-existing with any revised residential development (see highlighted section in enclosed LOU.R2 map for our existing site).

Not only would this retain an established local service provider, as per NPPF guidelines, but also preserve jobs for existing staff, thus avoiding significant adverse economic impact on a local business.

Incorporating Loughton Self Drive into the proposed plans would give an on-site low emission car club/hire option for new residents, as per the Council's Development Requirements for the site. It also deals with the restricted parking facilities in the new development plans and supports the NPPF guidelines on promoting sustainable transport and reducing greenhouse gas emissions with the use of low and ultra low emission vehicles.
