My wife and I bought our house in Limes Farm and have invested a lot into this with the hope of making it our permanent home. The reason we chose to reside in Limes Farm was due to its very strong community with facilities including shops, nurseries, communal halls, etc.

We also have a local Synagogue that has an active congregation with people of all ages. This is easily accessed due to the Public walking spaces and green area. The Public Open and green space are also used by our children, dog walkers, etc. leading to an active population. I am concerned that you are proposing to reduce this open space to build more houses which will cause lots of issues like lack of walking space, lack of spaces for parking, build up of traffic which is expected with a denser population living in the new built-up areas and causes for accidents.
