Ivy Chimneys Primary school is full in all year groups and was heavily oversubscribed last year with parents living less than half a mile from the school having to send their children to Coopersale and Theydon Garnon school. You cannot build more houses without addressing this inequality. There is a glaring lack of proposed infrastructure in this local plan.
