Representations to Table 2.1

- 1. Nexus Planning is instructed by St Congar Provincial to prepare representations to the Submission version of the Epping Forest District Local Plan (EFDLP). St Congar Provincial control land at Old Farm, Chigwell (the site).
- 2. We object to table 2.1 of the EFDLP, which identifies the level of housing planned for within the housing market area (HMA) and the proposed distribution of housing across it, which was agreed by all HMA authorities in a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) dated March 2017.
- 3. As detailed within our other representations, St Congar Provincial consider that the objectively assessed housing needs (OAN) for the HMA and District is demonstrably too low. Furthermore, Table 2.1 indicates a shortfall in housing provision even against the significantly too low OAN for the HMA and it also shows the Council unjustifiably providing only 11,400 of its 12,573 OAN over the Plan period.
- 4. Given the above, Table 2.1 is considered be unsound having regard to paragraph 182 of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF), as it is not positively prepared, justified or consistent with national policy.

Suggested Change

5. The full OAN for the HMA should be identified and a thorough assessment carried out as to the level of growth the HMA can sustainably accommodate.
