We support the Epping Forest Local Plan Submission Version, specifically Policy SP2 which sets out the Spatial Development Strategy for the period 2011-2033. We note the housing allocation for Epping has been reduced from 1,640 dwellings contained in the draft Local Plan to 1,305 dwellings in the Submission Version. This is still a sizeable allocation for Epping which currently has some 5,300 dwellings. The allocation will result in a 25% increase in the size of the town. It is imperative therefore that this population increase is matched by appropriate infrastructure provision.

In accordance with the test of soundness set out in paragraph 182 of the NPPF, we have reviewed the body of evidence supporting the Local Plan, and are of the view that Policy SP2 adopts a pragmatic approach to the quantum and distribution of new residential development across the district.

We note that the Spatial Development Strategy is based on a sequential approach to the allocation of sites (as contained in paragraph 2.66) and the Submission Version has given due weight to some of the more sensitive Green Belt locations which were advanced in the previous Draft Local Plan and revised the distribution strategy to bring it more in line with Government policy. The core planning principles set out in paragraph 17 of the NPPF promote a brownfield first principle and, as far as possible, Policy SP2 adopts this with a distribution which seeks to minimise the impact of new development on the Green Belt.

Policy SP2 promotes the most appropriate housing strategy when considered against reasonable alternatives, given that some 95% of the District is allocated as Green Belt. We therefore consider the approach is justified.

The strategy should be effective as it takes in to account the role of smaller sites, as well as larger strategic sites, and this will assist in achieving a deliverable housing target over the plan period.

Policy SP2 reflects the duty to co-operate in allocating land within the District to meet the needs of Harlow. This is supported as it will lead to a sustainable pattern of development, which will benefit from the accessibility and infrastructure provision in Harlow.
