We are writing to lodge our concern about the inclusion of the Coopersale and Theydon Garnon Primary School playing fields in the local plan and to object to the possible loss of this resource. You can see a detailed map showing site boundaries on page 28 of <http://eppingforest.consultationonline.co.uk/wp-content/uploads/sites/5/2016/08/Appendix-B1.4.2-Extract-for-Epping-p67-111-of-full-Appendix.pdf> The playing fields are of vital importance to the health and education of the children attending Coopersale and Theydon Garnon Primary School. This is the only suitable "soft PE" space available to children at the school and is used regularly for PE, recreation and afterschool clubs. Removing the space would prevent the school from providing "soft" space in accordance with Area guidelines for mainstream schools: BB103 (April 2014, updated 2015). Additionally the boundaries marked in the aforementioned map encroach on the paved playground, play equipment and an entire classroom. We hope this is a cartographical oversight as it would be extraordinary to consider removing classroom space whilst increasing housing stock. We are further concerned that the Coopersale and Theydon Garnon Primary School governors did not receive written notice that the local plan included the possibility of the sale of the school fields. We repeat our objection to the sale and development of the Coopersale and Theydon Garnon Primary School playing fields.
