Prior to the drawing up of the master plan, the policy relating to trees needs to be more strongly stated. Veteran and ancient trees need to be soundly protected. New planting should positively reflect the species growing in the neighbouring open countryside so as to lessen the impact of development on the surrounding landscape which is of high quality. Special care should be given to the female native black poplars in the Water Lane Area which are of national significance.
