## 4. <u>LANGSTON ROAD</u>

Discussion regarding the current position in relation to the retail park.

Area is described as a 'fashion outlet' – discussion in relation to the outlets to be made available in relation to retail marketing and food and catering.

The Council have stated that it is important that the retail park does not have a bad effect on trading in The Broadway. Planning for the retail park has taken place and has been classified as a fashion outlet with food outlets in store and excluding outside restaurants, supermarkets and food halls.

There are no reports at the present time and we can only request that Council Representatives attend meetings and report on discussions that take place.

New Local Planning Scheme currently in process.

It was reported that there is the possibility of contacting the National Planning Case Work Unit for advice.

Objections were made by the Loughton Residents Association to the Town Council and these were taken forward.

Supermarkets will not be allowed as it is considered they could have a detrimental effect on The Broadway.

Outline planning has not changed in relation to the original discussions.

The Town Centre Partnership can only discuss these matters with Council Representatives and other relevant organizations.
