


INTRODUCTION

On the 18th October 2016 the Full Council of Epping District Council passed the Draft Epping Forest District Local Plan for consultation during the period 31st October for 6 weeks. The Draft Local Plan contains a number of proposals for Green Belt release across the District to accommodate the requirement for delivery of 11,400 dwellings between the period 2011 and 2033 to meet the Council's housing needs. However there is much unrest among local communities who feel that additions to existing villages will not result in sustainable development. This document is intended to inform the local planning authority, local communities and other key stakeholders that there is a superior alternative proposal to the current strategy that has not been considered within the draft Local Plan.

This document seeks to profile proposals for the Roding Garden Village. The proposals are an alternative to the proposals within the Draft Local Plan and propose to create a new garden village comprising a mix of starter homes, market and retirement homes, school, community facilities and employment other uses within a single allocation in a sustainable location that is within walking distance of Debden tube station. This proposal presents an opportunity to relieve the pressure that is being placed on the villages such as Theydon Bois, Chigwell and Loughton through the current draft Local Plan and will be presented to the Epping Forest District Council in response to its current consultation.

Transport and train links to London via the M11 and Debden tube station.



EMPLOYMENT

200+ jobs would be provided through the care village as well as the new community facilities and shops.



HEALTH

Doctors surgery and private hospital.
