There is no indication that that improvements in infrastructure will be in place and if indeed it would be achievable by the time it would be required.

An Interim Sustainability Appraisal has been commissioned to support the Draft Local Plan. We would welcome any comments you may have on this.

At rush hour, school start and finish times, Theydon Bois is heavily congested with traffic. When the M25/M11 intersection is congested [a frequent occurence], Theydon Bois roads grind to a halt as motorists seek an alternative route. The underground is at capacity at peak times. There is woefully little parking at the station so commuters park on the road to Abridge - out MP has suggested that this will lead to traffic accidents. This village already has parking restrictions in place designed to prevent commuter parking. The Green Belt must be protected at all costs.
