There is a serious inconsistency in that sites near the Forest (within 400m and we argue elsewhere in our submissions on the MMs that this should be 1km or further based on survey work) remain allocated despite the MM arguing for a *cordon sanitaire* in which development intensification is strongly discouraged. Site LOU R7 (within 5 min walk of the SAC) is perhaps the worst of these, given that its owners have stated their intention to build a 5-storey block with 38 dwellings, more than double the allocated capacity.

The site should be deleted, or at the least its capacity should be kept strictly to 18 in view of Policy DM 2.
