I'm strongly objecting to the two sites on The Street, Sheering. This road is already extremely busy and has a number of extremely large lorries which are unable to pass without mounting the pavement. These developments will inevitably need access onto The Street, causing delays to an already busy road. The Daubney's Farm development will mean a loss of the grass frontage opposite Red Brick Cottages, which is currently used for parking - parking for houses which have no front garden and therefore no parking facilities is already at a premium. This will also mean development of the Green Belt - this paddock is a haven for wildlife, unlike the intensely farmed area to the rear of the farmhouse, which uses copious amounts of fertilisers.
