I am deeply concerned about the Council's draft local plan which will see housing built on Jessel Green. Not only is Jessel Green a space used by the whole community for sport activities, dog walkers and even the air ambulance service but it is one of the few green spaces in the area. The land itself is also totally unfit for housing, it is susceptible to heavy flooding in the winter and it would bring with it increased congestion on the road around it and the rail links both in Loughton and Debden. I believe it is wholly inappropriate to build such housing at a time when you are already cutting back transport links from Debden with fewer bus services.
