LOCAL PLAN VISION AND OBJECTIVES

- In setting the strategic context for this Plan, emphasis is placed on the Council working with its partner authorities to deliver the vision for the London Stansted Cambridge Corridor (LSCC) Core Area. We support this principle and the key elements of the vision which we see as:
 - Complementing and supporting the economic performance of the corridor;
 - Delivering housing;
 - Capitalising on existing economic sectors and promoting growth of expanding industries;
 - Protecting and enhancing the natural environment;
 - · Working with partners to invest in major infrastructure; and
 - The regeneration of existing urban areas.
- We particularly welcome the emphasis given to the development and sustainable growth of Greater Harlow in the context of the LSCC Core Area vision.
