With reference to the possible housing development on Debden's 'parks', in particular our Jessel Green. You do not realise how relaxing and stress relieving it is to walk up to the high point of Jessel Green and view the local countryside. You can see Theydon Bois and far beyond the Bank of England (see below picture). My children spent a lot of their time playing on Jessel Green and I could relax knowing that I could find them within minutes of leaving my house. Now, in my later years (being a pensioner), I can find rest and relaxation not far from my front door. The trees, carefully nurtured, provide valuable oxygen with all the car pollution increasing around our green. The green has also been used for vital landing space for air emergency services 3 or 4 times in recent memory. Our infrastructure cannot cope with the number of people we have now. My doctor appointment time in the last year has gone from 3 days to my last quoted 3 weeks. Any additional housing would overburden our infrastructure (and transport) and would be irresponsible of the council. A new town in our vast rural spaces would seem the logical solution.
