These are the reasons for my objection to the sites that have been identified for development: 1. One of the Councils objectives is to ensure that residents continue to enjoy a good quality of life. I believe using green space currently enjoyed for recreational purposes will reduce the opportunities for residents to enjoy areas that are vital for well being. If the Council is to develop in Loughton surely there are brown field sites that should be considered first. 2. With parking already at a premium in Loughton, the use of car parks for development will reduce space still further. This is not practical if we are to increase the number of homes in the area and develop the local economy. 3. There are no details of the services that will be needed to deal with the additional populace ie schools, health, transport etc. These considerations need to be a key part of the planning. 4. The roads in much of Epping Forest are overcrowded with queues in many key areas. Additional homes will only contribute further to this problem, affecting amongst other things, the attractiveness of the area, the local economy and residents quality of life. 5. The Central Line is already running at full capacity. People will be attracted to Epping Forest because of its easy commute into London, putting even further pressure on the tube network and by default, local residents already using the line. 6.

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Rather than trying to squeeze more housing into Loughton, would it not be more practical and realistic to plan for a new garden village as other Essex districts are doing.
