The plan is not compliant with national policy for the following reasons;

- 1/ No consultation has been made with relevant stakeholders.
- 2/ The draft local plan did not include the Stapleford Abbotts site.
- 3/ The current plan was presented on 18/12/17 the Stapleford Abbotts site was only added on 14/12/17.
- 4/ The draft plan stated that the site was "not considered suitable".
- 5/ The 4 aspects of consideration for development in a Green Belt area have not been met, with benchmarking examples showing the proposed site would score highly therefore would be in breach of Green Belt protocols.
- 6/ Access to the proposed site would be adjacent to an existing junction with poor visibility and a history of road traffic accidents.
- 7/ Shortage of places and accommodation in the village primary school.
- 8/ Increased load on power supply in a village where power cuts are currently frequent.
- 9/ Increased load on existing mains drains which cannot cope with current demand.
- 10/ Risk of flooding from existing adjacent brook.
- 11/ Due to the proximity of the this site to the conservation area of Havering-Atte-Bower the development would create issues with the London Borough of Havering
