With regard to the selected site in Thornwood THOR R1 - This land backing on to Brookfield is Green Belt Land. The benefit of this Green Belt land has not changed and with the addition of new housing already in Epping and Thornwood the value of Green Open Spaces where trees can counteract pollution and wildlife can thrive are vital. The plan to build approximately 124 new houses on this land is in no way sound. A major issue is the flood risk for all residents in Brookfield and other homes in Thornwood. My house backs on to the field and my garden is frequently flooded even with moderate rainfall. A development of this size will reduce the drainage and increase the risk of flooding. Brookfield consists of 30 homes, so the proposed development of 124 homes is four times this amount and will impact greatly on the infrastructure of Thornwood. The importance of avoiding urban sprawl has frequently been recognised to have a negative impact for all residents of Thornwood and Epping.
