This email is to outline my concerns as a local resident to the draft plan for 1,190 houses on 12 sites Key concerns are: over building on green spaces which make Loughton such a pleasant place to live and work. We, like many other families use green spaces such as Jessel Green to play games and to walk on. Such activities improve our quality of life and most importantly our children's'. These greens were deliberately planned to keep Loughton a leafy suburb and losing these greens will make Loughton another over crowded and built up suburb. Building on underground station car parks will only encourage people to park on already crowded residential streets. Also the Central Line is at capacity and it can be hard to get a seat at rush hour leading to a cramped and standing commute. There is simply not enough infrastructure - local schools are already over subscribed as are dental and doctors surgeries. Local roads are crowded already. Why aren't sites such as Woolston manor or further out from Rolls Park roundabout being considered? As a local resident I'm very worried about this plan and how it will affect people locally
